

Lesson 1: Key to the exercise on nouns and verbs

a) Nouns.

1. ὁ θεός = god, God

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ θε-ός	οἱ θε-οί
<i>acc</i>	τὸν θε-όν	τοὺς θε-ούς

2. ὁ διδάσκαλος = teacher

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ διδάσκαλ-ος	οἱ διδάσκαλ-οι
<i>acc</i>	τὸν διδάσκαλ-ον	τοὺς διδασκάλ-ους

3. ὁ ἵππος = horse

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ ἵππος	οἱ ἵπποι
<i>acc</i>	τὸν ἵππον	τοὺς ἵππους

4. ὁ δοῦλος = slave

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ δοῦλος	οἱ δοῦλοι
<i>acc</i>	τὸν δοῦλον	τούς δούλους

5. ὁ υἱός = son

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ υἱός	οἱ υἱοί
<i>acc</i>	τὸν υἱόν	τούς υἱούς

b) Verbs

1 θύ-ω = to offer sacrifice

<i>person</i>	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>1st</i>	θύ-ω	θύ-ομεν
<i>2nd</i>	θύ-εις	θύ-ετε
<i>3rd</i>	θύ-ει	θύ-ουσι(ν)

2 λέγ-ω = to say, speak

<i>person</i>	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>1st</i>	λέγ-ω	λέγ-ομεν
<i>2nd</i>	λέγ-εις	λέγ-ετε
<i>3rd</i>	λέγ-ει	λέγ-ουσι(ν)

3 παύ-ω= to stop (someone or something)

<i>person</i>	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>1st</i>	παύ-ω	παύ-ομεν
<i>2nd</i>	παύ-εις	παύ-ετε
<i>3rd</i>	παύ-ει	παύ-ουσι(ν)
