- 1) The master's son has a horse. ὁ υἱὸς τοῦ κυρίου ἔχει ἵππον.
GEN S V DO
- 2) The sons of the teacher are fleeing. οἱ τοῦ διδασκάλου υἱοὶ φεύγουσι(ν).
S GEN ---- V -----
- 3) We have the masters' food. ἔχομεν τὸν σῖτον τῶν κυρίων.
S + V GEN DO
- 4) Friend, you are shunning the slaves! ὦ φίλε, φεύγεις τοὺς δούλους
vocative ----- S + V----- DO
- 5) The doctors bring food to the slaves. οἱ ἰατροὶ φέρουσι σῖτον τοῖς δούλοις.
S V DO IO
