Tip: You may mark smooth and rough breathings, but it is a good idea not to use accents yet.

1) ὁ ἀγαθὸς ἄνθρωπος = the good man

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ	οἱ
<i>gen</i>	τοῦ	τῶν
<i>dat</i>	τῷ	τοῖς
<i>acc</i>	τὸν	τούς
<i>voc</i>	ὦ	ὦ

2) ὁ ὀρθὸς λόγος = the right argument

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ	οἱ
<i>gen</i>	τοῦ	τῶν
<i>dat</i>	τῷ	τοῖς
<i>acc</i>	τὸν	τούς
<i>voc</i>	ὦ	ὦ

3) ὁ ἐμὸς ἀδελφός = my brother

	<i>singular</i>	<i>plural</i>
<i>nom</i>	ὁ	οἱ
<i>gen</i>	τοῦ	τῶν
<i>dat</i>	τῷ	τοῖς
<i>acc</i>	τὸν	τούς
<i>voc</i>	ὦ	ὦ
