

Key to the declension of masculines and neuters of the 2nd declension

1) ὁ δούλος, -ου (masc) = slave

<i>Cases</i>	<i>Singular</i>	<i>Plural</i>
nominative	ὁ δούλος	οἱ δούλοι
genitive	τοῦ δούλου	τῶν δούλων
dative	τῷ δούλῳ	τοῖς δούλοις
accusative	τὸν δούλον	τούς δούλους
vocative	ὦ δούλε	ὦ δούλοι

2) ὁ πόλεμος, ου (masc) = war

<i>Cases</i>	<i>Singular</i>	<i>Plural</i>
nominative	ὁ πόλεμος	οἱ πόλεμοι
genitive	τοῦ πολέμου	τῶν πολέμων
dative	τῷ πολέμῳ	τοῖς πολέμοις
accusative	τὸν πόλεμον	τούς πολέμους
vocative	ὦ πόλεμε	ὦ πόλεμοι

3) τὸ δένδρον, ου (neuter) = tree

<i>Cases</i>	<i>Singular</i>	<i>Plural</i>
nominative	τὸ δένδρον	τὰ δένδρα
genitive	τοῦ δένδρου	τῶν δένδρων
dative	τῷ δένδρῳ	τοῖς δένδροις
accusative	τὸ δένδρον	τὰ δένδρα
vocative	ὦ δένδρον	ὦ δένδρα

4) τὸ δῶρον, ου (neuter) = tree

<i>Cases</i>	<i>Singular</i>	<i>Plural</i>
nominative	τὸ δῶρον	τὰ δῶρα
genitive	τοῦ δώρου	τῶν δώρων
dative	τῷ δώρῳ	τοῖς δώροις
accusative	τὸ δῶρον	τὰ δῶρα
vocative	ὦ δῶρον	ὦ δῶρα
