

KEY TO THE PRACTICE OF THE INFINITIVE

1) ἄγω = to lead

<i>case</i>		<i>translation</i>
<i>nom</i>	//τὸ// ἄγειν	to lead / leading
<i>gen</i>	τοῦ ἄγειν	of leading
<i>dat</i>	τῷ ἄγειν	by leading / (sometimes) to or for leading
<i>acc</i>	ἐθέλω ἄγειν	I wish to lead

2) ἀκούω = to hear

<i>case</i>		<i>translation</i>
<i>nom</i>	//τὸ// ἀκούειν	to hear / hearing
<i>gen</i>	τοῦ ἀκούειν	of hearing
<i>dat</i>	τῷ ἀκούειν	by hearing / (sometimes) to or for hearing
<i>acc</i>	ἐθέλω ἀκούειν	I wish to hear

3) πιστεύω = to believe

<i>case</i>		<i>translation</i>
<i>nom</i>	//τὸ// πιστεύειν	to believe
<i>gen</i>	τοῦ πιστεύειν	of believing
<i>dat</i>	τῷ πιστεύειν	by believing / (sometimes) to or for believing
<i>acc</i>	ἐθέλω πιστεύειν	I wish to believe
