- 1) They considered the poets friends of the Muses.  
S + V DO pr acc gen

ἐνόμιζον τοὺς ποιητὰς φίλους τῶν Μουσῶν

- 2) The philosopher's disciples were considered enemies of democracy.  
gen S V P NOM gen

οἱ φιλοσόφου μαθηταὶ ἐνομίζοντο ἐχθροὶ τῆς δημοκρατίας.

- 3) Who will call toil a gift?  
S V DO pred acc

τίς πόνον ὀνομάσει δῶρον;

- 4) καὶ μικρὸν δῶρον δεῖ καλὸν νομίζειν.  
adv .....do..... IMPERSONAL VERB pred acc inf = S

*It is necessary to consider even a small gift nice.*

- 5) (εἰ σοφοί ἔσονται), [ποιήσουσι τοὺς φιλοσόφους τυράννους]  
conditional clause main clause  
PN S + V V DO pred acc

If they("will be" = ) are wise, they will make the philosophers kings.
