The path of pleasure is easy, but the path of excellence / virtue is hard.

S PN gen V gen PN

Victory is not the gift of chance, but the reward of excellence/virtue.

dat of manner VDO..... .pred acc V

You (sg) learn the Greek language, but you consider //it// difficult.

5) τὰ τέκνα ἔβαινε / ἔβαινον ἐς τὸ ἱερόν διὰ μακροῦς ὕλης.

S V V ἐς +acc διὰ +gen

The children were walking to the temple across a large forest.

17) ἐγὼ λέγω, σὺ δ' ἀκούε μου.

S V S V gen w/V

I am speaking, listen to me.

18) ἐμοῦ ἀκουε, σοῦ γὰρ δέομαι.

genw/V V genw/V V

Listen to me, I beg you.

19) ἐμὲ οὔτε ἀπιστον οὔτε πονηρὸν νομίζουσιν.

DO pred acc pred acc V

They call me neither disloyal nor wicked.

ἐγὼ οὔτε ἀπιστος οὔτε πονηρὸς νομίζομαι.

S PN PN V

I am called neither disloyal nor wicked.

20) τίνων ἐκ χώρας ἦκετε;

gen ἐκ+ gen V

From whose (pl) land have you arrived?

21) πότε οἱ πόνοι παύσονται;

adv S V

When will grief come to an end?

22) ποῦ αὐριον ἔση;

adv adv V

Where will you (sg) be tomorrow?
