

### REVIEW 1.15: Adverbs

An easily recognizable ending of adverbs encountered in this course is:

**-ως** as the ending of a stem known to be that of an adjective of Type 1.

Examples: **καλῶς** = well, beautifully, from **καλός**; **κακῶς** = badly, poorly, from **κακός**.

The neuter sg, and sometimes the neuter pl, of an adjective may be used as an adverb:

Examples: **μόνον** = only    **πολλά** = often ("many times")    **πρῶτον** = first, firstly

Many other adverbs need to be memorized as part of one's vocabulary.

Examples: **αἰεί / ἀεί** = always; **εὖ** = well; **ἔτι** = still, yet
