

Summer Arts Workshops Student/Parent (or Guardian) Agreement

We strive to make **Summer Arts** a rewarding experience for your child, one where he or she will have fun, learn and grow artistically. To ensure a safe and enjoyable workshop for all, Blaffer Gallery puts forth the following guidelines. Please read the information below, making sure both you and your child understand these expectations.

1. Adhering to the arrival and pick-up times of children from Summer Arts are of the utmost importance. Motivational time, directions for projects and occasional tours of the exhibitions in the gallery will begin promptly at 9:30 am with teaching and instructions given as a group. Children must be present for this important information in order for them to be able to participate in the project for that day.

Students may not be dropped off prior to 9:15 am as there is no adult supervision available. Likewise, the program ends promptly at 12 noon. Teaching staff are not responsible for nor can they stay to supervise children past this time.

2. We welcome your child to the program and plan for another exciting round of art adventures. Each project is tailor-made for the age range of students participating with the exhibits at Blaffer Gallery being their motivation. In preparation, please look at and read the available information sent prior to the workshop with your child explaining what Summer Arts is and the projects that are planned. Each student enrolled in summer arts should be willing to participate to the best of their abilities. There are no alternate activities for students who choose not to participate in that day's project.

3. Excited children, wonderful art and creative projects make for an amazing experience. In order for everyone involved to have a safe and enjoyable time, the adherence to rules set by the teaching staff must be followed by the students. Following the basic rules of positive classroom behavior is the expectation of students participating in Summer Arts. Students will be expected to listen attentively, show respect to both students and teachers, be actively involved in projects and practice safety first at all times.

The parents of any student who chooses not to participate or follow the behavior guidelines listed above will be contacted in order for them to be picked up.
